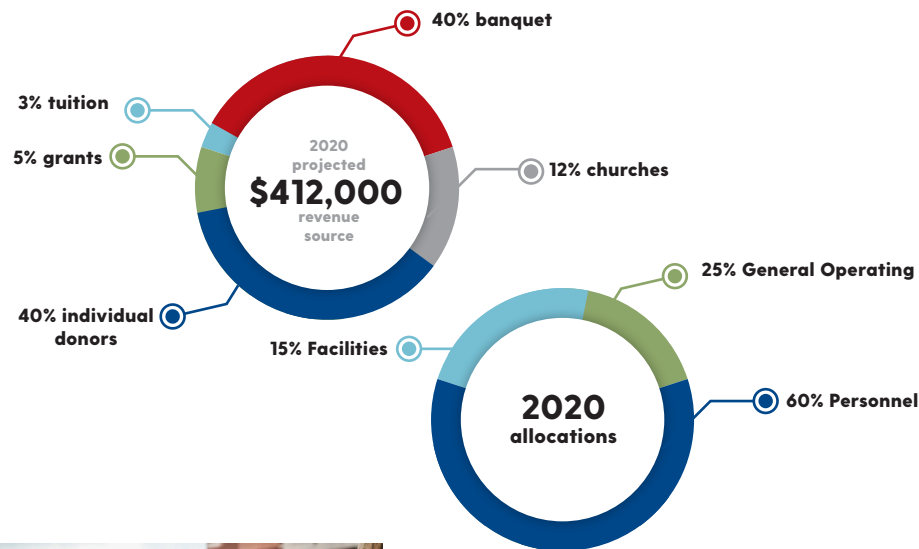
PARENT ENGAGEMENT: Cultivates a healthy relationship with parents by equipping and empowering them with tools and resources to encourage positive parenting
